I personally made the audit request for the Palm Beach County Ethics Commission with the Senate President on February 13<sup>th</sup>, 2013. I also met with OPPAGA staff that day to discuss the potential audit. To my knowledge, Philip Massa's interview took place March 21<sup>st</sup>, 2013 thirty six days after my audit request. He was officially notified in writing April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2013 that he did not receive the position.

It has never been more apparent to me that an audit is necessary to obtain information and have a thorough review for how the board conducts itself.

It is irresponsible that someone in a position representing high ethical standards would make allegations in contradiction to a factual timeline without making any attempt to verify their negative assertions.

I am sure we agree that it is imperative to have an ethics commission that is properly trained, free from influence and one that never holds prejudice. As an openly and historically strong supporter of our Inspector General and ethics oversight, I will continue to work to ensure that the process is above reproach. I respectfully request a meeting after the conclusion of the legislative session.
